

## LAMPTON & HOUNSLOW SCHOOL TERM AND HOLIDAY DATES 2016/2017

The dates set out below are based on a 195 pupil-day. The dates are those recommended by the London Inter Authority Admissions Group (LIAAG) and are likely to be adopted by most neighbouring boroughs. The first day of term would be designated as an INSET day for all schools.

### **AUTUMN TERM 2016**

**Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September to Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October** 35days

*Half Term – Monday 24<sup>th</sup> October to Friday 28<sup>th</sup> October (5 days)*

**Monday 31<sup>st</sup> October Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December** 35days

*Christmas break – Monday 19<sup>th</sup> December to Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2017*

### **SPRING TERM 2017**

**Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> January to Friday 10<sup>th</sup> February** 29days

*Half Term – Monday 13<sup>h</sup> February to Friday 17<sup>h</sup> February (5 days)*

**Monday 20<sup>th</sup> February to Friday 31<sup>st</sup> March** 30 days

*Spring Holiday Break – Monday 30<sup>th</sup> May*

*Good Friday: 14<sup>th</sup> April*

*Easter Monday: 17<sup>th</sup> April*

*Easter break Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> April to Monday 17<sup>th</sup> April*

### **SUMMER TERM 2017**

**Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> April to Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May** 28days

*May Day: Monday 1<sup>st</sup> May*

*Spring Bank Holiday: Monday 29<sup>th</sup> May*

*Half Term – Monday 29<sup>h</sup> May to Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> June (5 days)*

**Monday 5<sup>h</sup> June to Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July** 35days

This makes 195 days for schools. Headteachers will need to designate, in consultation with staff, 5 non-teaching staff development days (INSET), which may be allocated as whole day training sessions during pupil holiday periods or by the use of additional hours before or after school sessions. It would be for Headteachers to determine, in consultation with their staff, whether it would be appropriate for one or more of the 5 professional days to be allocated more flexibly as twilight sessions.

Governors/Management of Academies, Voluntary Aided and Foundation schools have the responsibility for determining the dates and times of school terms and holidays but, in order to assist parents and staff, may well wish to adopt this framework.

Where a school is required to close for polling duties, schools will need to take one inset day in twilight in order for the school to close for the day, or use the polling day as an inset day. .
