

## **ITT Assessor**

### **Role**

The ITT assessor will play a key role in the development of outstanding provision for trainees in the Lampton LWA SCITT so that trainees are enabled to maximise their progress and students are able to benefit from a high quality of teaching. Assessment will be rigorous against the Teachers Standards and across the cohort. The post-holder will support, monitor and advise on school based provision as well as assessing trainee progress towards the Teacher's standards.

### **Responsibilities**

- Monitor the quality of the school based placements including compliance of provision with the SCITT MOAs and / National ITT requirements through
  - Individual training programmes
  - Mentor practice
  - Host school provision
- Support the development of outstanding ITT practice through
  - Support for participating schools, mentors and trainees
  - Liaison with the SCITT central team
  - Acting as the first point of contact between the school and the SCITT
- Assess progress towards the Teachers Standards through
  - Observation schedule as decided by the SCITT and additional observations as agreed by the SCITT
  - Scrutiny of evidence provided by the trainee and school in the portfolio and other places
  - Monitoring of completion of Subject Knowledge audit through the year
  - Participation in the interim and final assessment process on behalf of the SCITT
- Contribute towards the self-evaluation process and cycle of improvement through
  - Evaluation of trainee experience
  - Participation in SCITT meetings as agreed

### **Time**

Lead 3 assessment visits per trainee/ 0.5 day per visit to include write up

Allocation of number of trainees will be agreed with the SCITT central team

### **Payment**

£200 per visit (paid to employer or to self employed individual following monthly invoice) to include transport costs
