# Maths Teacher – Full/Part time

Mathematics is a highly successful subject at both GCSE and A level at Lampton School. RAISE 2016 data shows achievement and progress to be sig+ at GCSE and in the top 6% nationally. Almost all of our students are entered for the Statistics GCSE in Year 10 as well as for the Mathematics GCSE in Year 11. At A level, the number of students wishing to study Maths is high and many students go on to study Maths or related subjects successfully at university. The department has pioneered a highly successful programme of support for GCSE students by AS or A2 students in the school.

The department has developed and implemented a 'conceptual' curriculum at Key Stage 3 to support transition to the demands of the revised GCSE; It is also well prepared the reformed maths AS and A level starting this year. Each Key stage is led by a Key Stage coordinator who takes responsibility for curriculum development in their particular areas.

The department is very outward facing and makes a valuable contribution to the training of new teachers. It supports PGCE training on the traditional route as well as hosting School Direct placements. All members of the department support training teachers. It takes a high number of School Experience Programme Participants thinking of teaching as a career and hosts short placement for teachers from across the world. In addition, it has pioneered a Maths project which is developing the capacity of Maths teachers and secondary and primary Maths departments across London to support primary students operating at the current Level 5 or 6. It is a member of a Challenge Partners Maths network – collaborating with other schools on the development of mathematics.

Lampton School is a mixed, multi-ethnic 11-18 school that gained Academy status through the fast track 'outstanding' route in September 2010. We were awarded Teaching School status in July 2011. We have IIP Status. Lampton School was judged as "outstanding" in all categories by Ofsted in May 2008. It was also featured in the Ofsted report 'Twelve outstanding secondary schools – Excelling against the odds'.
